#### SOFT RAFTING ON TAGLIAMENTO

#### FARM TOUR & WINE TASTING

#### DONKEY WALKING Ideal for kids

Walk at a slow pace following the donkeys' and pony's steps. Learn somethings about these cautious and stubborn animals.

The length of the walk is determined according to the conditions of the terrain and the group. For older groups, it can also be done in the dark to discover the nocturnal sounds of the forest.

# WILD BREAD BAKING Ideal for kids

In this evening activity, the children will try baking a primitive bread. In a sweet or savoury version. This ancient bread has remained in the tradition of pilgrims, hunters and Crâmàrs, typical historical figures from Friuli. The complete activity includes the different steps: The preparation of the dough. The search in nature for useful baking tools. The lighting of the fire and patient cooking. It is agreed with the parents whether to carry out all or only part of the steps.
